The Ultrasonographer II is responsible for performing a variety of general and specialized Ultrasound procedures on clients for the purpose of achieving accurate client diagnoses so as to ensure a high quality of health care.	
6. SPECIFIC ACCOUNTABILITIES			

The Ultrasonographer II:

- □ Performs various ultrasound procedures, inclusive of specialised examinations and complex procedures.
- Maintains a high standard of ultrasound imaging by (i) Leading quality assurance and quality control initiatives and (ii) Assisting in the formulation, implementation, monitoring and updating of ultrasound policies, procedures and protocols, in keeping with professional standards of practice.
- Directs the duties of professional, technical, nursing and clerical staff and their allocation and rotation within the Ultrasound Department.
- Conducts performance management activities inclusive of but not limited to performance evaluation of subordinate staff.
- □ Assists in preparing monthly and daily rosters and assists with supervising Ultrasonographer I's, nursing and administrative staff.
- □ Maintains accurate client records both manually and electronically with regard to appointments, statistics and reporting.
- □ Manages, monitors and controls inventory/consumables used in ultrasound.
- □ Supports clinical training by mentoring, assessing, supervising and guiding staff and students as necessary in the work area.
- □ Assists the Manager-Para-Clinical Services in reporting and investigating complaints, incidents, accidents or grievances in accordance with established policies.
- □ Assists in the formulation of improved patient care pathways and imaging protocols.
- Operates ultrasound equipment safely and demonstrates an active role in their daily maintenance and quality assurance checks.
- Ensures that equipment malfunction and/or change in image quality is notified promptly to the Head of Department and Biomedical Department.
- Observes procedures designed to promote quality, Health & Safety within the department.
- □ Participates in on call duties as required by the department.
- □ Performs related work as may be required by the approved Authority.

- □ A minimum of five (5) years' experience in the healthcare environment inclusive of at least three (3) years postgraduate experience in active Ultrasonography practice.

- □ Certification in specialized ultrasound procedures would be an asset.
- □ Associate membership or registration with the American Registry Diagnostic Medical Sonographer or equivalent would be an asset.
- □ Any equivalent combination of training or experience.
